



2020 VENDOR TERMS AND CONDITIONS AGREEMENT

- 2020 Festival**
1. The sixth annual Ukrainian summer festival is scheduled to occur from July 24-26, 2020 at 952 Green Valley Crescent, Ottawa, ON.
- Vendor Categories**
2. There are three categories of Vendors:
Food Vendors: prepare and sell food for consumption at the Festival.
Pop-up Tent Vendors: include all vendors not selling ready to consume food and who would like to operate in their own pop up tent.
Table Vendors: include Artisan and Commercial Craft Vendors who would like to rent table space under the large, shared tent. Artisan Craft Vendors are persons who make crafts by hand, often using traditional methods. Commercial Vendors sell products that are not 100% made by the Vendor, or packaged foods (for take home only).
- Mandatory Vendor Hours**
3. Vendor hours are subject to change at the discretion of the Capital Ukrainian Festival.
Friday, July 24, 2020 (5:00pm–10:00pm)
Saturday, July 25, 2020 (11:00am–10:00pm)
Sunday, July 26, 2020 (11:00am–6:00pm)
- Load In & Set Up**
4. Food Vendors with mobile units are encouraged to arrive at 952 Green Valley Crescent, Ottawa, on Thursday, July 23, 2020 between the hours of noon and 3:00 pm to set up.

5. Vendors with 10 x 10 tents are encouraged to arrive at 952 Green Valley Crescent, Ottawa no later than Friday July 24, 2020 between the hours of 8:00 am and noon to set up.
6. Table Vendors operating in the Marketplace Tent are required to arrive at 952 Green Valley Crescent, Ottawa, on Friday, July 24, 2020 between the hours of 12:00 noon and 2:00 pm to set up.

Fees & Payment

7. Vendors will not be permitted to Load In and Set Up if the Capital Ukrainian Festival has not received payment in full.

Inspection Timelines and Penalties

8. Vendors should be fully set up and ready for bylaw inspection on Friday July 24, 2020 at 2:00 pm. Vendors unprepared for the City of Ottawa inspections will be held responsible for any difficulties, costs, or penalties incurred by the Festival, and may not be permitted by City Officials to operate.

Restocking

9. Vendors cannot bring vehicles onto the grounds during the event for any reason. Restocking must be done by hand cart.

Take Down

10. Vendors may take down their booths no earlier than Sunday, July 26, 2020 at 6:00 pm.
11. Vehicles will not be permitted on the grounds before the 6:00 pm closing time on Sunday July 26, 2020.

Environmental Stewardship

12. The Capital Ukrainian Festival is committed to having an environmentally responsible event and is working closely with our partners to plan and implement an event which will reflect Green Event best practices.

Think Green

13. Vendors are encouraged to:
 - a. Eliminate and/or reduce waste by using recyclable or biodegradable paper plates, napkins and beverage containers,
 - b. Be mindful of the amount of brochures you distribute (i.e., offer information to the public via your website as an alternative),
 - c. If offering giveaways, avoid those that have a short lifespan or are not recyclable. Use of helium balloons is

- discouraged at the Capital Ukrainian Festival,
- d. Reduce your carbon emissions to get to the event (i.e., walk, or carpool with your co-workers),
 - e. Reduce plastic waste, and
 - f. Provide environmentally sound products.

- Trash** 14. Spaces must be free of trash, litter and other refuse at all times. Each night, all Vendors **MUST** dispose of their corrugate, recycling, compost and garbage.
- Site Clean-up** 15. Upon conclusion of the Festival, Vendors are responsible for removing their equipment and waste and returning their site to its pre-festival condition. This must commence immediately upon the closing of the Festival on Sunday, July 26, 2020 at 6:00 pm.
- Security** 16. Vendors are responsible for the security of their own property and equipment at all times. Security patrols will be on site at 952 Green Valley overnight on Friday July 24-26, 2020. However, leaving any valuables on site is at the Vendor's own risk. No security personnel will be assigned specifically to Vendors.
- No Pets** 17. No dogs, except service dogs, are permitted at the Festival.
- Conduct** 18. Vendors must be suitably attired at all times. All Vendors are encouraged to wear Ukrainian ethnic clothing.
19. Vendors may not smoke or consume alcoholic beverages within any assigned space.
20. Vendors will not engage in loud, live or recorded music during the Vendor hours unless approved by the Festival.
- Canvassing** 21. Vendors may canvass only from inside their booth space. Canvassing from outside of the booth space is not permissible and Vendors shall be liable for immediate closure, removal from the Festival and loss of all submitted monies.
- Sales** 22. The Capital Ukrainian Festival does not guarantee sales or audience size.

Content	<p>23. No merchandise shall be sold, distributed or displayed that may be construed as unlawful, threatening, libelous, defamatory, obscene, scandalous, inflammatory, pornographic, or profane or any other material that could give rise to any civil or criminal liability under the law.</p>
Space	<p>24. Booth-sharing is not permitted, and all products must be wholly owned or represented by the Vendor renting the booth space. Any subletting, sharing or promoting of products by Vendors that does not officially represent exhibit space is not permitted.</p> <p>25. Vendor merchandise, products and services, including restocking supplies must fit within the allocated space provided.</p>
Rules and Regulations	<p>26. All vendors are responsible for maintaining a safe environment and must comply with the provisions of all Federal, Provincial, and Municipal rules, regulations and policies.</p> <p>27. It is the Vendor's responsibility to know these rules and regulations.</p> <p>28. Booths will be inspected by the authorities concerned and at any time deemed necessary to ensure compliance with rules and regulations.</p> <p>29. The Capital Ukrainian Festival will not be held responsible for any difficulties, costs, or penalties incurred in relation to the current regulations.</p>
City of Ottawa Licences and Permits	<p>30. It is the responsibility of the vendor/exhibitor to contact the City of Ottawa regarding necessary licenses, permits, and any public health requirements. Food Vendors require certain permits and licences from the City of Ottawa.</p>
Electrical Services	<p>31. The Capital Ukrainian Festival will provide electricity to all Vendors as part of the booth rental fee.</p> <p>32. There shall be no electricity, generators, trailers, vans or other such mechanical devices allowed on the premises unless approved by the Capital Ukrainian Festival.</p>

**Electrical
Safety**

- 33. Vendors are responsible for their own power cords. All extension cords must be properly grounded, of the three-prong type, and must contain wires of the proper gauge to carry the electrical load. The electrical inspector will not allow any connection where the Vendor's wiring method constitutes a code violation.
- 34. Vendors are responsible for any necessary materials to tape down all exposed cords (i.e., duck tape, gaffers tape, etc...)

Fire Safety

- 35. Vendors are required to meet and follow Fire Safety regulations and requirements. Fire extinguishers, with a minimum rating or classification of 2A 10BC, are mandatory for Food Vendors and must be in their booth for the entire duration of the Festival. Food Vendors are responsible for their own fire extinguishers.
- 36. Fire marshals will conduct inspections during the set-up and at any time during the event. They will reject anything that does not meet the fire code and fire regulations.
- 37. Any Food Vendor who plans to bring propane tanks on-site must inform the Capital Ukrainian Festival no later than July 10, 2020.

**Health and
Safety
Regulations**

- 38. Food Vendors are advised and encouraged to follow and maintain health standards, and take all control measures laid down by the Ottawa Public Health department and concerned authorities.
- 39. Food Vendors must abide by the City of Ottawa's existing health regulations. Food Vendors must complete and provide the Capital Ukrainian Festival a copy of the Ottawa Public Health Vendor Information Package completed and returned to Ottawa Public Health by Friday, July 3, 2020.
- 40. Health inspectors will conduct inspections during the event. They will close any booth that does not meet existing health regulations.

**Liability
Insurance**

- 41. Food Vendors must be covered with a \$2,000,000.00 (2 Million dollars) Liability Insurance Policy and provide the Capital Ukrainian Festival with a Certificate of Insurance naming the Capital Ukrainian Festival and St. John the Baptist Ukrainian Catholic Shrine as Additional Insured to the commercial liability rider of the Vendor's policy.

42. The Certificate of Insurance shall be received by the Capital Ukrainian Festival no later than Friday, July 3, 2020.

43. The Vendor's insurance carriers and policy provisions must be acceptable to the Capital Ukrainian Festival and must remain in effect for the duration of the Event.

Proof of Insurance

44. Food Vendors will not be permitted to Load In and Set Up if the Capital Ukrainian Festival has not received a copy of \$2,000,000.00 (2 Million dollars) Liability Insurance Policy Capital Ukrainian Festival with a Certificate of Insurance naming the Capital Ukrainian Festival and St. John the Baptist Ukrainian Catholic Shrine as Additional Insured.

Production and Promotion

45. The Capital Ukrainian Festival reserves the right to market and promote the Capital Ukrainian Festival at its discretion.

46. The Capital Ukrainian Festival shall be entitled to advertise and promote the appearance of Vendor.

47. The Vendor acknowledges that the Capital Ukrainian Festival will rely on the terms hereof in all such promotions and advertising and in the brochures to be printed setting forth the names, dates and times of the Marketplace (Yarmarok).

48. The Vendor hereby acknowledges and agrees that the Capital Ukrainian Festival may use their names, photographs, likeness, and any other promotional materials in all of such promotions, advertising or other activities used to increase attendance at the Capital Ukrainian Festival.

Signage

49. Vendors may only display its own business signs and banners within the assigned booth space.

Merchandise

50. Revenue from the Vendor's merchandise sales at the Capital Ukrainian Festival belongs solely to the Vendor.

Exclusivity

51. Vendor participation and product sales at the Capital Ukrainian Festival is non-exclusive.

- Taxes** 52. The Vendor agrees that they have sole responsibility for the payment of any federal or provincial taxes arising from the monies paid by patrons of the Capital Ukrainian Festival to the Vendors related to the sale of their merchandise.
- Force Majeure** 53. If Vendor participation in the Capital Ukrainian Festival is prevented, rendered impossible or unfeasible by any act of regulation of public authority or bureau, civil tumult, strike, epidemic, war conditions or emergencies, including, but not limited to, any event cancelations resulting from the COVID-19 virus, or any other cause beyond the control the Capital Ukrainian Festival, it is understood and agreed that there shall be no claim for damages by either party to this contract.
- Weather Conditions** 54. Vendors are reminded that the organizers of the Capital Ukrainian Festival are not responsible for the weather conditions on the day of the event. Vendors may wish to inquire about purchasing insurance to protect them against damage or loss due to inclement weather.
- Indemnification of Property Damage or Loss** 55. The Vendor recognizes, acknowledges, and assumes full risk of any injury, property damage or loss, which he/she may sustain as a result of his/her participation in any and all activities connected with or associated with the Capital Ukrainian Festival.
- Violations** 56. Vendor acknowledges that a breach of any of the terms and conditions of this Agreement may result in the termination of this Agreement and the preclusion of the Vendor's participation in the Capital Ukrainian Festival.
57. In the event this Agreement is terminated as a result of any breach by the Vendor, the Vendor shall not be entitled to any refund, but shall forfeit all amounts previously paid as liquidated damages.
- Waiver and Release from Liability** 58. The Vendor waives and relinquish all claims he/she may have or may in the future have against the Capital Ukrainian Festival, and he/she releases from all liability the Capital Ukrainian Festival, and Saint John the Baptist Ukrainian Catholic Shrine, and any of their directors, officers, employees, members, employees, servants, agents, volunteers, contractors, suppliers, representatives, (collectively, the "Personnel") for any personal

injury, death, property damage claims arising from my participation in the Capital Ukrainian Festival, whether it arises from facilities, activities, other loss that I sustain as a result of his/her participation in the Capital Ukrainian Festival, from to any cause whatsoever, on the part of any one or more of the Capital Ukrainian Festival, and Saint John the Baptist Ukrainian Catholic Shrine, the personnel or others, including but not limited to: negligence (the meaning of which includes failure to use such care as a reasonably prudent and careful person would use under similar circumstances); breach of any other duty imposed by law, breach of any contract; and mistakes or errors in judgment of any kind.

Indemnity

59. In consideration of being allowed to operate at the Capital Ukrainian Festival, the Vendor agrees to indemnify and hold the Capital Ukrainian Festival, harmless from any claims, demands, suits, or actions howsoever, wheresoever, and whensoever arising from his/her participation in the Capital Ukrainian Festival and binding upon the Vendor's family, heirs, and assigns.

Severability

60. If any provision of this Agreement or the application thereof is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Agreement which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Agreement are declared to be severable.

Additional Fees

61. Vendors will be charged an additional amount and are liable if the Capital Ukrainian Festival incurs any:

- a. additional cleaning expenses to clean the vendor booth area, and
- b. fines or penalties due to the negligence of the Vendor.

Refund and Cancellation Policy

62. The Vendor understands in the event the Vendor cancels after June 1, 2020, the entire booth fee will be forfeited. Cancellations before June 1, 2020 will incur a \$100.00 non-refundable fee.

Authority to Execute

63. The representative who is executing this Agreement on behalf of Vendor hereby warrants and represents that he/she has the full power and authority to bind the Vendor on whose behalf he is executing this Agreement and acknowledges that he/she is making this representation and warranty with the understanding

that the Capital Ukrainian Festival is relying thereon.
